House Select Committee on Domestic Violence

NCCADV supports the recommendations from the House Select Committee on Domestic Violence, including the following items proposed by NCCADV:

- New felony crime of non-fatal strangulation
- Warrantless arrest for violation of pre-trial release conditions
- Employment protection for victims who miss work to obtain a domestic violence protective order
- Increased funding for domestic violence programs

Funding

- Increase state funding by \$2 million for domestic violence programs.
- Increase the marriage license fee by \$20 to fund domestic violence programs.

Workplace Violence

NCCADV supports the Attorney General's office in pursuing legislation that would allow an employer to obtain a protective order on behalf of an employee who has suffered unlawful conduct from any individual at the workplace.

Civil No-Contact Order

NCCADV supports the North Carolina Coalition Against Sexual Assault in pursuing legislation to create a civil no-contact order for victims of sexual assault and stalking who may not have a relationship with the perpetrator.
