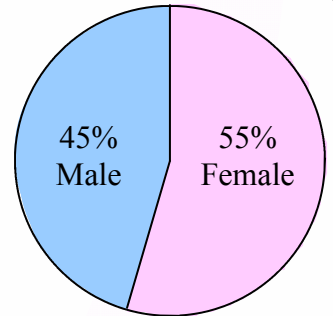


NORTH CAROLINA'S WOMEN VOTERS

BY STATE...

Women make up the majority of registered voters in North Carolina. Of the 5.8 million registered voters in NC, 55% are female and 45% are male. However, state representation has been overwhelmingly dominated by males. Only 38 of the 120 representatives in the State House are women and only 7 of our 50 state senators are women.

BY COUNTY...

County level voter registration data by gender mirrors overall trends in the state. In the six most populated counties in North Carolina, the number of registered voters approximates the state's percentages for both males (45%) and females (55%). Similarly, the number of male and female elected officials for the same counties show that the vast majority of elected leaders are male.
